

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Albert Welch has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Carpenter Spring through pipe line for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 7 T. 2 N., R. 57 E., M.D.M. or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 7 bears N. 86° 32' W., 1779 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appertenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Albert Welch
Post-office address Adaven, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.009 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 29, 1940

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is conveyed from Carpenter Spring through about 1320' of 1 1/2" pipe and about 2 1/2 miles of 1" pipe to three troughs with capacity of 750 gallons each. Overflow from troughs flows into a small reservoir about 40' in diameter. Place of use is in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 21, T. 2 N., R. 57 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
