CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Arthur D. Browne, Owner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Franklin Springs through pond for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 15, T. 26 N., R. 55 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 15 bears S. 21° 23' E., 2130 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 800 cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 20, 1929

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A small pond excavated below spring for watering stock. Place of use is in the said NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 15, T. 26 N., R. 55 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
