CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. A. and Rachel C. Roberts has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Big Timber Spring (Lower Diversion) through pond for Stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 29, T. 20 S., R. 57 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Section 29 bears N. 73° 30' E., 1315 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0046 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 cattle.  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation December 20, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water stored in pond 20' long and 10' wide formed by an earth and rock filled dam 25' long and 3' high. Place of use is in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 29, T. 20 S., R. 57 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
