CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS B.F. Porter Estate through Porter Sesnon has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Battle Creek Spring

through Small ponds for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 18, T. 40 N., R. 27 E., unsurveyed or at a point from which the S.W. corner of Section 14, T. 40 N., R. 27 E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 82° 04' E., 16,400 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator E. F. Porter Estate, a corporation

Post-office address 58 Sutter Street, San Francisco, California.

Amount of appropriation 0.023 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 750 head of cattle.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 15, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Small pools constructed in the channel leading from the spring and located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 18, T. 40 N., R. 27 E., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
