

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, T.8N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 19, T.8N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 33°29'40" E., a distance of 230.72 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Owner of record: **John Uhalde & Company**

Source: **Underground**

Manner of use: **Stockwater**

Amount of appropriation: **0.031 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 5,000 sheep, but not to exceed 22.4 acre-feet annually***

Period of use: **January 1st through December 31st of each year**

Date of priority: **February 28, 2011**

Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 80 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a pump and motor, thence to a 6,000-gallon water tank and trough where 5,000 head of sheep water within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, T.8N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Hardy Spring Grazing Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the following term:


***The total combined duty of water under Permit 80634, Certificate 20046; Permit 80635, Certificate 20047; Permit 80636, Certificate 20048; Permit 80637, Certificate 20049; and Permit 80981, Certificate 20050 shall not exceed 22.4 acre-feet annually or sufficient to water 5,000 sheep.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
