CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Lot 6 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 6, T.9N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 6, bears N. 36°05' W., a distance of 1,416.8 feet situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Owner of record: **Dr. C.E. McCafferty**

Source: **Indian Spring**

Manner of use: **Stockwater**

Amount of appropriation: **0.0015 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 50 horses, but not to exceed 1.12 acre-feet annually***

Period of use: **January 1st through December 31st of each year**

Date of priority: **May 16, 1919**

Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:


Water is diverted from Indian Spring by a spring box, thence through a pipeline to a 500-gallon tank and trough, thence through ditches to small reservoirs where 50 horses water within the W $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, T.9N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the following term:

***The total combined duty of water under Permit 5501, Certificate 20053 and Permit 7673, Certificate 7810 shall not exceed 1.12 acre-feet annually, or sufficient to water 50 head of cattle or horses.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
