

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Walter R. Bracken has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through pipe lines for Municipal supply and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 30, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Section 30 bears S. 16° 34' E., 663.7 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Las Vegas Land and Water Company
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation: 1.0 c.f.s. or 723 acre-feet per year.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 30, 1941

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water developed by means of a 489' drilled well cased with 280' of 13 3/8" and 231' of 10 3/4" casing, and conveyed through 98' of 10" C.I. pipe; 174' of 12" transite pipe and 800' of 12" C.I. pipe to settling basin, thence through 24" and 16" mains to City of Las Vegas as shown on map filed under Permit 10508.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
