CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. C. Florio has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground Source
(Hay Ranch Well)

through storage tank pipeline & troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In Lot 13 or NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 31, T. 20 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{2}$ cor. of said Sec. 31, bears N. 31° 33' E. 684.8 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator A. C. Florio

Post-office address Eureka, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.094 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 10,000 sheep and 1,000 cattle.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 19, 1942

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Hay Ranch Well is 110 feet deep and has a 6 inch casing. It is equipped with a gasoline engine and pump. The water is pumped from the well into a Redwood Storage Tank, having a capacity of 1,000 gallons. Water is conveyed from the storage tank by means of a pipeline to two (2) steel troughs, located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
