CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. J. Bradshaw has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Robber Roost Spring through pipeline and trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 18, T. 6 S., R. 66 E., M.D.R.&N., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of Section 35, T. 5 S., R. 66 E., bears N. 15° 00' W., 16,335 feet, situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: R. J. Bradshaw
Post-office address: Elgin, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0036 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle and 15 horses.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 20, 1943

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is conveyed from the spring by means of 700 feet of 3/4" (inch) pipe to a wooden water trough 12" x 4" x 18" located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion. One mile of constructed trail leading to trough.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
