CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. D. Spencer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Eagle Spring through pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T. 23 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed or at a point from which the NE Cor. Section 1, T. 21 N., R. 34 E., bears S. 7° 25' 07.6" E. 59,865.60 feet. situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Fallon, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.003 c.f.s. or sufficient water to water 50 cows and 50 horses.
Period of use, from March 1 to September 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 24, 1928

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of 15 feet of tunnel and conveyed by means of 30 feet of 2" pipe to two metal troughs, 10 feet long and located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T. 23 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
