CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from flood water from melting snow

through earthen tank and reservoir for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 11, T. 45 N., R. 49 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 35, T. 46 N., R. 49 E., bears N. 5° 56' E., 6,530.5' situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Petan Company
Post-office address Tuscarora, Nevada,
Amount of appropriation 0.16 c.f.s. or sufficient water to water 5,000 cattle.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 29, 1943

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is impounded in a combination earthen tank and reservoir by constructing a levee 465 feet long and 5 feet high across a ravine. The total capacity of this tank and reservoir is 6.70 acre feet, or 2,183,213.626 gallons and rarely fills more than once a year.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
