CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. J. Stinson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground source (Artesian Well) through pump, storage tank, pipelines, trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 13, T. 8 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of Section 1, T. 7 N., R. 36 E., bears S. 11° 22' 30" W., 19,065.4 feet, situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: W. J. Stinson
Post-office address: Carson City, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0156 c.f.s. or sufficient water to water 500 cattle.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 29, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
An artesian well equipped with a 12 inch casing and 450 feet deep. Water is pumped by means of a 3 H.P. gasoline engine driven Meyer's self-oiling pump equipped with 3 inch suction pipe and a 2 3/4 inch suction rod. Water is pumped directly into a 1,000 gallon storage tank; thence by a 2 inch pipeline to a trough, having a capacity of 250 gallons and equipped with a float control, located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 13, T. 8 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
