CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. A. Hail has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Troy Creek through diversion, dam, ditch, reservoir for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 30, T. 6 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 24, T. 6 N., R. 56 E. bears N. 36° 10' W., 8,840 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Buck Horn Cattle Company  
Post-office address: Alamo, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation: 0.00156 c.f.s. or sufficient water for 50 cattle.  
Period of use, from May 15 to October 15 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation: June 11, 1942

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
An earth and rock dam placed in the channel of Troy Creek diverts the water into a ditch 2 feet wide and 1 foot deep. The ditch conveys the water to an earth reservoir located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 24, T. 6 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
