CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, G. M. Standifer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 3)

through pump and pipeline for Mining

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 23, T. 16 N., R. 21 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE 1/4 Corner of said Section 23, bears N. 31° 28' W., 2,625 feet, situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address San Bruno, California.

Amount of appropriation 1.34 c.f.s. or 600 gal. per min.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 12, 1941

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
A 100 foot 14" cased well is used to provide water for pond in which a floating washing plant is floated. The well is equipped with a Byron Jackson 40 H.P. 6" deep well pump; pumping direct through 9" iron pipe to dredge pond, where it is repumped to washing plant to wash placer gold from gravel. The gravel area to be treated is located in the W 1/2 E 1/2 and W 1/2 Section 23, T. 16 N., R. 21 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
