CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John E. Marble by Milton B. Badt, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Union Spring No. 4 through pipeline and trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 14, T. 39 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 Corner of said Section 14 bears S. 72° 00' W., 1,091 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John E. Marble
Post-office address Deeth, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.072 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1500 head of cattle and 4000 sheep.
Period of use, from April 1 to December 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 16, 1928

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Spring dug out and cleaned and fenced one rod square with 55" woven wire, steel and cedar posts. Water is conveyed by means of 80' of 2" pipe to a framed steel trough 10' x 16" x 28", located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 14, T. 39 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
