CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank D. Rathbun, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Valley Artesian Basin) through a system of pipelines for Irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 Corner of said Section 28 bears S. 10° 10' E., 1176.2 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appertenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Vera K. Clement, Merrill O. Clement, Lydell W. Clement and Lee Waite.
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation: 0.045 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 28, 1943

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A drilled well 690 feet deep with 400 feet of 8 inch casing, 200 ft. of 7 inch casing and 533 feet of 4 inch standard pipe controlled by two 4 inch gate valves. The water is distributed by means of 640 feet of 4 inch pipe, 110 feet of 2 inch pipe and an unknown amount of 1 inch pipe. Water is conveyed to 4.27 acres in the N.E. corner of the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
