CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Juanita W. Bleak has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dead Man Spring through open cut, pipeline & steel tank for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 26, T. 1 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. Corner of said Section 26, bears N. 67° 23' W., 5,147 feet, situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Juanita W. Bleak & Cassey L. Wheeler
Post-office address: P. O. Box 89, Pioche, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0031 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 75 cattle and 25 horses.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 3, 1943

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Spring developed by means of an open cut 6 feet by 12 feet; twenty feet of 2 inch pipe conveys the water to a steel tank with a concrete bottom located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 26, T. 1 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
