CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Norman T. Hilbrecht, Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through Sunrise Acres Water Distribution System for Municipal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 36, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 36 bears N. 36° 42' W., 1797.74 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.31 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 14, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: An 8" artesian well, 500 feet deep, cased 467 feet with 8" I.D., 32# pipe. A 7 1/2 H.P. deep well pump, turbine impeller type, with 150 feet 5" column, pumps the water into distribution mains; the excess amount of water goes into an elevated storage tank from which distribution is carried on when pump is off. 3/4" pipe lines convey the water from the mains to 96 residential units located in the E 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 36, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. Water from this well is used in conjunction with water from well covered by Permit No. 11640.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
