CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Alma Woods has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Surface Flow from Monitor Valley through Alma Woods Reservoir No. 1 for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35, T. 19 N., R. 47 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of Section 36, T. 19 N., R. 47 E., M.D.B.&M, bears N. 81°02' E., 7,240 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.009 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 3, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Surface flow of Monitor Valley is collected by drain ditches on the southside of highway 50 and conveyed to an earthen reservoir, 300 feet long, 100 feet wide, and 6 feet deep located in the W 1/2 NE 1/4, Section 35, T. 19 N., R. 47 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
