CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS George H. McKaig has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, (McKaig Well) through pump, pipeline and pressure tank for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 7, T. 17 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.W. Section Corner of said Section 7, bears S. 58° 18' W., 2,725.5 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.10 c.f.s. or 72.27 acre feet per annum.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 4, 1946

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
5 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 7, T. 17 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.
5 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 7, T. 17 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.
10 acres total.

Note: Water is pumped from an artesian well, 100 feet deep, by means of a 2 H.P. electric pump and conveyed by means of 50 feet of 3/4" pipe to a 225 gallon pressure tank and thence to a residence for domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
