

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, D. L. Stewart, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Jumbo Spring through pipeline and trough for Stockwatering and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 9, T. 7 S., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the S. E. corner of Sec. 32, T. 8 S., R. 65 E., M.D.M. bears S. 27° 00' E., 59,300 feet. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator D. L. Stewart
Post-office address Alamo, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.003 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 14, 1944

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Spring developed by means of an open cut 150 feet long, with a 15 foot face. Water is conveyed by means of 200 feet of pipeline to a trough 12 feet long, 4 feet wide and 2 feet deep, located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 9, T. 7 S., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
