CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. A. Henriod, Stock Grower has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Henriod Well No. 3)

through pump, troughs and reservoir for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 7, T. 23 N., R. 66 E., M.D. B.&M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Section 18, T. 23 N., R. 66 E., bears S. 14° 23' W., 5,948 feet.

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Eugene A. Henriod

Post-office address McGill, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.004 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 80 head of cattle and 2300 sheep.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 11, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
A well 30 feet deep and 4 feet in diameter cased with concrete, equipped with a windmill, gas engine, pump jack, and pump rod. Water is conveyed to 50 feet of 24" galvanized troughs and a reservoir 40 feet long, 20 feet wide and 2 feet deep, located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 7, T. 23 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
