CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. B. Stewart has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Summit Spring through dam and ditch for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 18, T. 32 N., R. 41 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.W. Corner of said Section 18, bears N. 61° 34' W., 3,204 feet, situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.044 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 7,000 sheep following
Period of use, from November 1 to March 15 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 17, 1942

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A small earth dam constructed at the spring, diverts the water into a ditch that runs in a northeasterly direction across the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 and the S 1/4 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 18, T. 32 N., R. 41 E., M.D.B.&M. Small dams are placed in the ditch to form pools to facilitate the watering of 7,000 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
