

THE STATE OF NEVADA  
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. F. Bordoli has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Twin Springs Slough through reservoir for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW<sup>1</sup> NE<sup>1</sup> Section 24, T. 5 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N. W. corner of Section 6, T. 4 N., R. 55 E., bears S. 10° E., 15,580 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0078 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 250 cattle.  
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation November 10, 1944

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
An earthen dam 250 feet long and about 5 feet high constructed across the channel of Twin Spring Slough, that forms a reservoir or catch basin, with an area of about 5 acres. Run-off water from rain and snow is captured in this reservoir. The reservoir is equipped with a spillway that allows surplus water to be by-passed. The dam and reservoir are located in the NW<sup>1</sup> NE<sup>1</sup> Section 24, T. 5 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
