CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Laura Gentry has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hartman Wash through catch basin for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 6, T. 17 S., R. 70 E., M.D.B.&M.

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Overton, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.0006 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 20 head of cattle.  
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation June 26, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
A concrete dam 6 feet high by 10 feet long by 1 foot thick, constructed across a break in the sandstone and forming a catch basin 150 feet long, 75 feet wide and sloping to a depth of 5 feet, and located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 6, T. 17 S., R. 70 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
