CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Porter Sesnon has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Bartlett Peak Spring through small ponds for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25, T. 42 N., R. 27 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{2}$ corner of Section 31, T. 42 N., R. 28 E., bears S. 51° 23' E., 5,257 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.03125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 15, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Earth dams are placed in the channel leading from the spring, forming small ponds that facilitate the watering of cattle. All the ponds are located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25, T. 42 N., R. 27 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
