CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry Filippini has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Springs (Burton Springs)

through dam and ditches for Irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 23, T. 27 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M.

situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Henry Filippini
Post-office address: Battle Mountain, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation: 0.3849 c.f.s. or 141.20 acre feet per season.
Period of use, from March 15 to September 15 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 16, 1915

Table with 2 columns: Description of land to which the water is appurtenant; and Acres Total. Rows include 6.89 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 23, T. 27 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M., and a total of 38.49 Acres.

Application No. 7014 was filed to change the place of use of water under Permit No. 3625, hence the priority of October 16, 1915.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
