WHEREAS, A. E. Holgate, County Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well)

through wells and pipelines and ponds for Fish Culture

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 19, T. 19 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of said Section 19 bears S 42° 32' 30" W., 1,412.5 feet.

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 8, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is conveyed from the well by means of approximately 2,600 feet of pipe to rearing ponds located in the E 1/2 NW 1/4 Section 30, T. 19 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
