CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Clay Hughes Tipton, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Summit Creek through Dam and ditches for Irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, T. 32 N., R. 41 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S. W. Corner of said Section 16, bears South 1,053.00 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:  
16.30 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, T. 32 N., R. 41 E., M.D.B.&M.  
Note: 0.025 c.f.s is allowed from September 16 to March 14 of the following year for domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
