CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Kent Land & Livestock Company, Stockgrowers by Ira H. Kent, Agent, of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Mountain Well) through pump, pipe line and storage tank for Stock watering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 2, T. 13 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed or at a point from which the N 1/4 Corner of Section 5, T. 19 N., R. 32 E., bears N 20°-42' W., 38,096.00 feet. situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Kent Land and Livestock Company
Post-office address: Stillwater, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.03 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 5, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A dug well 4' x 4' and 35 feet deep. Water is pumped from the well into a storage tank thence into a stockwatering tank 12' x 16' x 2' 8" located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 2, T. 13 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B. & M. Unsurveyed

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
