CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Kent Land & Livestock Co. and Ira H. Kent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Kent by Ira H. Kent, Agent an underground source (Sheep Canon Well) through wind Mill, pump, pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 6, T. 19 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the NE Corner of Section 1, T. 19 N., R. 31 E., bears N 41°-38' W., 5,080.00 feet. situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Kent land and Livestock Company and Ira H. Kent
Post-office address Stillwater, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.03 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 5, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A 90' dug well with 6 inch casing and equipped with rods, cylinder and wind mill. Water is conveyed to a round watering tank, 12 feet in diameter and 3 feet deep located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 6, T. 19 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B.&M. unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
