

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Lloyd H. Tritle has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source Las Vegas Valley Artesian Basin through Pump, tank and pipelines for Domestic and Irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 30, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Corner of the said Section 30, bears N. 41°58' E., 1,814.4 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 10, 1944

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped into a 1,000 gallon tank by means of a pressure pump. Water is conveyed to the house and sprinkling system by means of 3/4 inch pipelines, and are located in the E 1/2 of the NE 1/4 Section 30, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. Water is obtained from a well 322 feet deep with a 10" diameter, and cased with 322 feet of 10" casing.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
