CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. W. Fallini, Agent and Partner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (George's Water)

through Pipeline and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T. 1 S., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed or at a point from which the NW Corner of Section 6, T. 1 S., R. 51 E., M.D.M., bears N. 36°30' E., 12,175.00 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Fallini Brothers (Partnership E. W., R. A., J. B. Fallini and Constant Vener)
Post-office address Twin Springs, Via Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.032 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle and 25 horses

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 29, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

An open cut, 100 feet long, 6 feet deep and 3 feet wide. About 300 feet of 2 1/2 inch pipe conveys the water from the face of the cut to one steel watering trough 16' x 4' x 2', located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T. 1 S., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M. Unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
