CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. D. Cornell, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Six Mile Manse Spring through pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, T. 21 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of T. 21 S., R. 54 E., M.D.M., bears N 48°35' E., 16,780 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.022 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 700 cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 27, 1944

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water developed by means of an excavation into a clay bank. The excavation is dammed off with a dam constructed of Railroad ties and clay, and is 8 feet long and 4 feet high. 50 feet of two inch pipe conveys the water from the dam to two watering troughs of 300 gallons each and located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, T. 21 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
