CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. A. Henriod and James E. Doutre, Stockraisers, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Henriod-Doutre Well) through Wind Mill, storage tanks and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 10, T. 20 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 31, T. 21 N., R. 67 E., M.D.M., bears North 9,275.00 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: E. A. Henriod and James E. Doutre
Post-office address: McGill, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.04 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 5,000 sheep and 180 cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 11, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A drilled well, 200 feet deep and cased with 6" casing. A wind mill pumps the water into a concrete storage tank 14'x14' and 4 1/2 feet deep, and thence to 46 feet of galvanized troughs, located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 10, T. 20 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
