CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Chris Dahlstrom has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Brickyard Springs through pipeline and trough for Stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 36, T. 2 S., R. 41 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the East 1/4 Corner of said Section 36, bears N. 77°00' E., 4870.00 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.00125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 40 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 17, 1917

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The spring has been timbered and the water is conveyed by pipeline to a watering trough 4'x4'x15', located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
