CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. T. Stewart, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Naquinta Valley Dry Channel (Reservoir No. 1) through Dirt Reservoir in Channel for Stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 14, T. 7 S., R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M.; unsurveyed or at a point from which Oak Spring Butte Monument, bears S. 71°00' W., 95,700 feet. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: W. T. Stewart
Post-office address: P. O. Box 2003, Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 5 acre feet per annum or sufficient to water 300 cattle and 10 horses
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 22, 1940

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A reservoir with a 5 acre foot capacity is formed by placing a dirt dam, 5 feet high and 100 feet long across the bed of the channel. Dam and reservoir are located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 14, T. 7 S., R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
