R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the N.E. Corner of said Section 11, bears N. 10°00' E., 1,400 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,
