CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, K.K. Hood, Manager, Callahan Zinc-Lead Co. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Mine tunnel and underground mine workings) through PUMP, pipelines and storage tank for Mining, Milling and domestic purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 and NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 7, T. 22 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed or at points from which the NW Corner of Section 6, T. 22 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 27° - 55' - 30" W., 8,167.7 feet and N. 24° - 20' W., 8,747.8 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 2, 1944

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Construction of concrete dam in an underground tunnel; pipelines from No. 2 tunnel to domestic water mains (about 500 feet of 2" pipe) which conveys the water to a wood storage tank 20' x 8', located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 7, and thence used on the N 1/2 and N 1/2 S 1/2 Section 7, T. 22 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed. Water is pumped from mine workings thru a 4" pipe to surface and into the above named storage tank. Thence to mill thru a 3" pipe approximately 300 feet long.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
