purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 10, T. 5 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of Section 18, T. 5 N., R. 44 E., M.D.M., bears S. 68°-51'W., 20,460 feet  
situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0187 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 600 head of cattle.

Period of use, from October 1 to May 31 of following ~~at~~ year

Date of priority of appropriation August 8, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
A drilled well, 150 feet deep equipped with 6 inch casing. Water is pumped by means of a windmill and conveyed to a 5,000 gallon tank, and thence to watering troughs holding approximately 150 gallons and located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 10, T. 5 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
