CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Wayne McLeod, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cherry Gulch Spring through pipe line and trough for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW<sup>1</sup> SE<sup>1</sup> Section 19, T. 45 N., R. 29 E., M.D.M., unsurveyed or at a point from which the S<sup>1</sup> corner Section 13, T. 45 N., R. 28 E., bears N 55° 50' W., 7472.0' situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.038 cfs. or sufficient to water 1200 head of cattle  
Period of use, from March 1st to December 1st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation November 4, 1943

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Dug 44' of trench to clean out Spring and the installation of 88' of 2" pipe thru which water is conveyed to a 150 gallon trough. Place of use is within the SW<sup>1</sup> SE<sup>1</sup> Section 19, T. 45 N., R. 29 E., M.D.M. unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
