CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank D. Rathbun, Civil Engineer, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin)

through Well and pipe lines for Quasi - Municipal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NE1 NE1 Section 9, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 9 bears N 47° 30' 30" E., 1518.3'

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator El Rancho Hotel, Inc.,

Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.20 cfs

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 26, 1940

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water developed by means of a drilled well 550' deep which is equipped with a 5 H.P. electric driven Peerless deep well turbine. Water distributed thru 1900' of 4" pipe and an undeterminable amount of smaller pipe. Water from this well is co-mingled with water from a well under permit No. 10718. Place of use is within the SW1 NE1, NE1; NW1 SE1 NE1; SE1 NW1, NE1 and the NE1 SW1 NE1 Section 9, T. 21 S., R. 61 E. MDH.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
