CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James M. Daniels has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

through pipeline and trough for

Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T. 8 S., R. 44 E., M.D.M., Unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SW Corner of Section 32, T. 8 S., R. 43 E., bears S. 67° 35' W., 55,400 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator. A. A. Daniels & J. M. Daniels, known as Daniels Bros.

Post-office address. Goldfield, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation. 0.005 c.f.s., for watering 300 cows and 15 horses

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation. May 14, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water developed by means of a well 50 feet deep and diverted by means of a windmill through 30 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe to a circular trough 8 feet in diameter and 3 feet deep. Place of use is within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 14, T. 8 S., R. 44 E., M.D.M., Unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
