CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. J. Moore, Hotel Manager has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well and pipelines for General Hotel Supply and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 9, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Section 9, bears S. 77° 54' W., 1422.4 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Hotels El Rancho, Inc.
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.292 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 19, 1944

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water developed by means of a 585' well, cased to 200' with 10" casing, 389' of 6" perforated casing from 196' to 585'. Water pumped with 25 h.p. Pomona turbine pump to a 20,000 gallon storage tank and distributed through 7200' of 4" pipelines to places of use. Water also used on 6 1/2 acres of ground landscaped with lawns, trees, etc. Place of use is within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 16, and SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 9, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
