CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Ernest Higbee and Erwin Burns has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dry Channel and Tributaries through Reservoir for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 8, T. 6 S., R. 60 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the S.E. Corner of Section 10, T. 6 S., R. 60 E., bears S. 77° E., 15,840 feet. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Erwin Burns and Ernest Higbee
Post-office address Hiko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.005 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 head of following cattle.
Period of use, from September to April of 1944 year
Date of priority of appropriation August 24, 1944

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water diverted into reservoirs formed by dirt dams. No. 1 reservoir is 300' long by 600' wide and No. 2 reservoir is 400' long by 100' wide. Place of use is in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 8, T. 6 S., R. 60 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
