of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from
Barton Spring
through pipeline and troughs for

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of
1937 has determined the date, source,
purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Floyd A. Walsh and A. Roy (Noux) Nesbitt
Post-office address: Hiko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0031 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority priority of appropriation: September 17, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water conveyed from spring through 1 �" pipe to concrete troughs having
a capacity of about 2400 gallons. Place of use in about the NW 1/4 NW nép
Section 23, Tar 2 N., R. 56 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed
the amount above (specified), and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which
acquired.
