CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harold J. Stocker, Hotel Owner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through pipe lines for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 Corner of said Section 2 bears S. 79° 47' W., 1502 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water developed by means of a 490' drilled well cased with 10", 8" and 6" casing. The installation of a 3 H.P. Peerless pump electrically operated and a 1000 gallon pressure tank. Water conveyed to places of use within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M., through 1000' of 2" pipe.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
