CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Elizabeth and Charles Hammond has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hiko Spring

through tank and pipe lines for Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 13, T. 32 S., R. 65 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 Corner Section 1, T. 32 S., R. 65 E., M.D.M., bears N. 6° 20' W., 10,680 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.002 c.f.s. for 153 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 24, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water diverted from spring through 110' of 1" pipe line to a concrete tank 3' wide, 3' deep and 12' long, thence through 300' of 1 1/2" pipe line to house and garden. Place of use is within the N 1/2 NE 1/4 said Section 13, T. 32 S., R. 65 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
