CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Elizabeth and Charles Hammond has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Sacatone Spring

through pipeline and tank for

Stockwater and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 18, T. 31 S., R. 66 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the S.W. Corner of said Section 18 bears S. 74° 50' W., 730 feet.

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Charlie and Elizabeth Hammond

Post-office address: Box 47, Needles, California

Amount of appropriation: 0.002 c.f.s. for 150 head of cattle.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: October 24, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water conveyed from spring through 60' of 1" pipe line to concrete tank 3' wide, 3' deep and 12' long and to Line Cabin. Place of use is within the said SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 18, T. 31 S., R. 66 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
