

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Elizabeth and Charles Hammond has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Discovery Spring through pipeline and tank for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 12, T. 31 S., R. 65 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the S.E. Corner of Section 13, T. 31 S., R. 65 E. bears S. 33° 20' E., 7260 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Charlie and Elizabeth Hammond
Post-office address: Box 47, Needles, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.001 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 25 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 30, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water conveyed from spring through 40' of 3/4" pipe line to a metal tank 3' deep and 6' in diameter. Place of use is within the said SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 12, T. 31 S., R. 65 E., M.D.M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
